Jesus calls His followers to work together and get along—within our own families and within His church. Solid relationships are crucial to developing family unity. As children and parents grow closer to one another, they're better able to learn and grow together. They also can open up and trust others to help them make their way through life. It's the basic principle of the body of Christ at work.

Family unity can be challenging to put into practice, especially during summer months. More down time leads to boredom, and boredom

leads to bickering.

Here are some tips to keep the peace in your family and strengthen bonds:

Pray for each other. Lifting up other family members in prayer makes it difficult to stay angry at them.

Serve one another. Challenge siblings to perform one act of kindness for each other every day.

Don't play favorites. Strive to ensure equal treatment in all areas of family life.



Praise good behavior & cooperation whenever you see it.

Don't solve children's disagreements for them, but don't let conflicts escalate to physical violence. If necessary, separate siblings for a while. They'll be eager to play with one another again.
